## TEAM JAMAICA goes on a sales blitz in CURACAO & ARUBA AUGUST 12-15

InselAir started operations in August 2006 with one Embraer 110-P1 Bandeirante flying from Curação. The first flight was to the neighbouring island of Aruba. Soon after the daily scheduled flights to Aruba, Insel Air started with flights to the other neighbouring island of Bonaire and also Las Piedras in Venezuela. The company has grown into an airline with 13 aircrafts (Embraer Bandeirante, Fokker 50 and MD82/83) - eleven (11) of which are owned by Insel Air. With the addition of these aircrafts, the total number of seats in Insel Air's fleet rose spectacularly from a very modest 19 seats in 2006 to 1,259 seats in 2013.

Insel Air has maintained steady and positive growth over the years of operation and are now in expansion mode via special agreements and strategic alliance. A recent agreement with KLM –Royal Dutch Airline for mutual interline cooperation was reached, thus expanding their services to their passengers. As of March 2011, passengers carrying a KLM ticket can now also fly to all Insel Air destinations. Passengers will be transported on one ticket and with automatic baggage transfer via InselAir's hubs in Curacao and St.Maarten. Due to this agreement, KLM passengers can now connect seamlessly and continue their flights to more destinations via InselAir's flights. A win/win situation for everyone involved. For Kingston (Jamaica), San Juan (Puerto Rico), Santo Domingo in the Dominican Republic, Port au Prince (Haiti) and Las Piedras (Venezuela), KLM and Insel Air have reached a code share agreement. On December 1, 2012, code share flights commenced between both carriers.
